

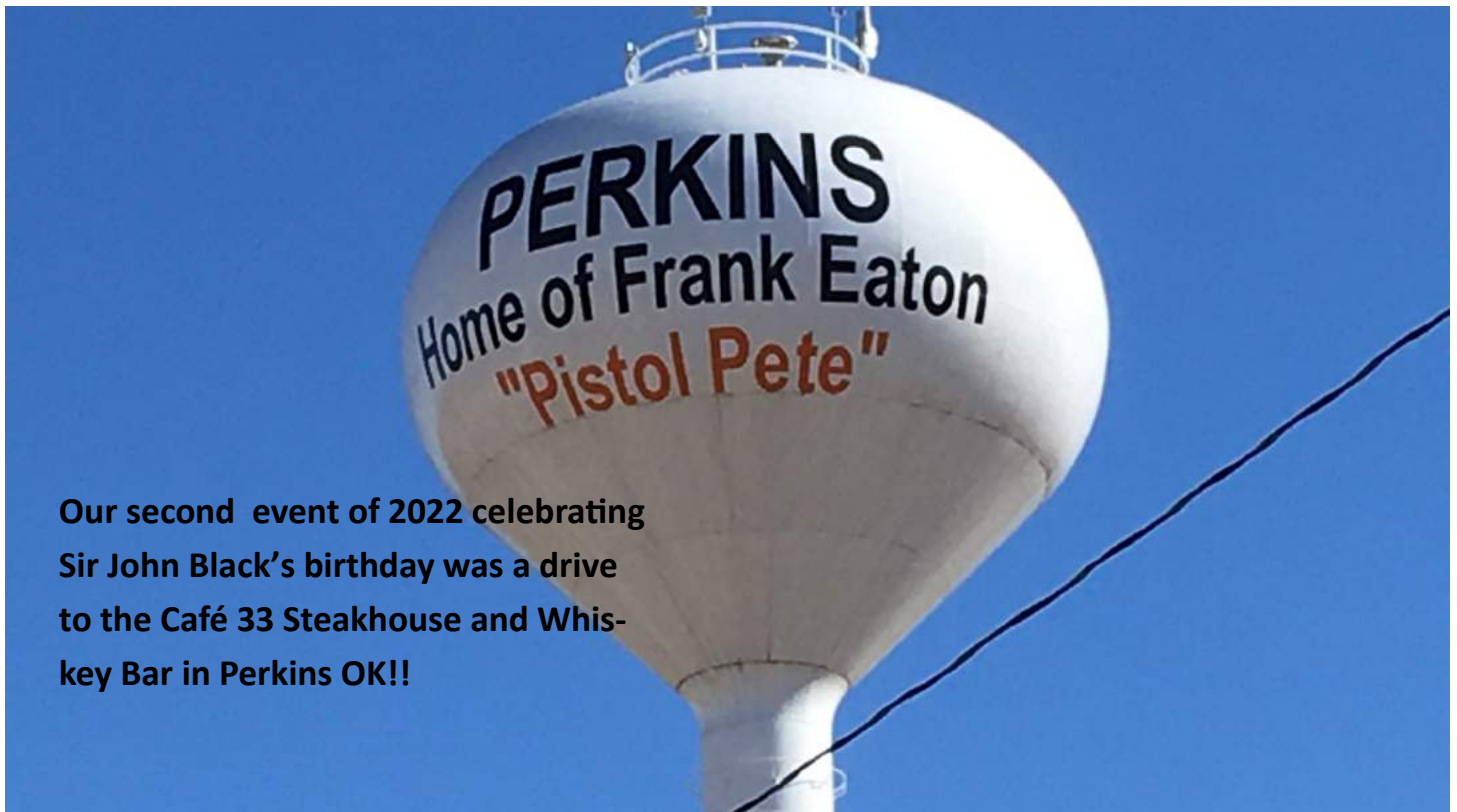

As your club begins planning for the New Year, we hope you will schedule the South Central VTR Regionals on your club calendar and make preparations to attend.

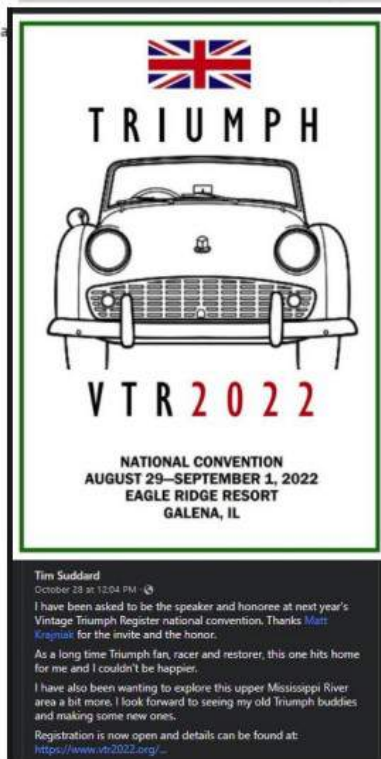
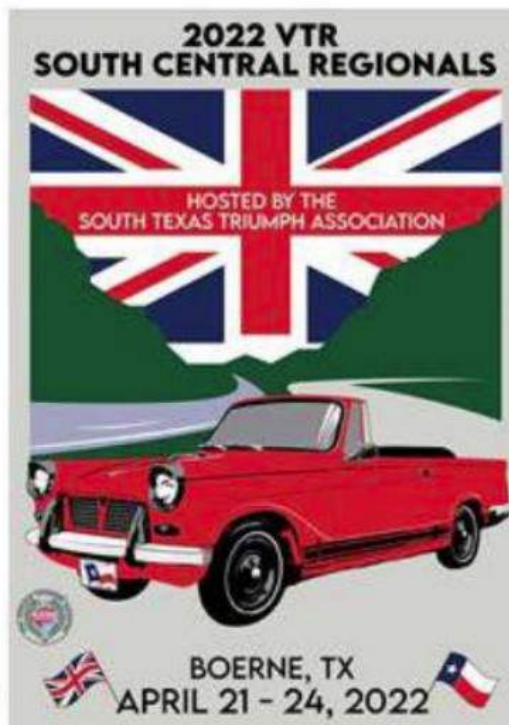

Minutes of COVTR Membership Meeting – February 8, 2022

Officers Present:

Treasurer – Mike Piggott, Secretary – Judy Piggott (covering for Dave Hogan)

Treasurer Mike Piggott opened the meeting at 7:03 PM by leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

Secretary Meeting Minutes: motioned by John Colson that we should accept the minutes of the 1/11/2022 meeting as printed in the January newsletter, seconded by John Barron. Motion carried.

Membership Report –

New members Doug and Margaret White from Tuttle came to the meeting. They have a GT-6. Welcome Doug and Margaret!

Treasurer's Report – Mike Piggott

Before Mike Piggott read the current Treasurer's Report to the membership, he explained to the new members about the Nationals. We had a great turn-out of 160 cars and around 300 people. COVTR and GREEN COUNTRY TRIUMPHS hosted the Nationals in September 2021. COVTR split the profit with GCT. GCT decided to donate their profits to McPherson College and COVTR agreed to do the same. After subtracting the profits (approximately \$7,800 to McPherson College) from the Nationals, COVTR has a current balance of \$12, 251.59. John Gauldin moved to accept the treasurer's report and Roger Harms seconded. Mike doesn't want to publish the detailed report in the newsletter, but anyone who wishes to see the report can request to receive an email and Mike will email them the report. Mike told the membership that he had spoken to VTR chief judge in Texas, Paul Higley. Paul told him that

VTR will reimburse the club for the special awards. Paul also told Mike that Jane is doing quite well after having complications from cancer.

Activities Report – Mike Piggott

The only activity in January was the Lunch Drive organized by John Gauldin and was covered in the previous newsletter.

The next event will be Thursday, February 10, 2022, Drive Your Triumph Day to celebrate Sir John Black's Birthday. COVTR will meet up with members from Green Country at the Steak House and Whiskey Bar in Perkins at 11:30 am.

Reminder: Mike said that the important Annual Planning Meeting will be scheduled as soon as the officers return from their trips.
